High School Courses offered to qualified 8th graders: Biology, Algebra, and Computer Science

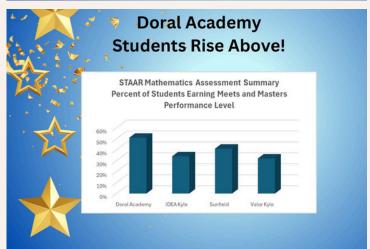
