Did my child sign up for a club during Club Rush?

No. Club Rush was simply an opportunity for students to see which clubs are being offered during lunch. Students were provided information but did not sign up. It is the parent's responsibility to complete registration. Each student received a letter and viewed the boards displayed on campus.

When does club registration open? Registration begins Wednesday, August 27th.

When does club registration close? Registration closes Friday, September 5th.

How do I know if my child is registered for a club? Club sponsors will contact the registering parent/guardian by September 12th, 2025.

Are clubs filled on a first-come, first-served basis? Yes.

Please note: Completing the registration form does not guarantee your child a spot. The form indicates interest only. The club sponsor will contact you directly with confirmation based on availability.

If my child doesn't get in, what happens? If a student withdraws or has frequent absences, their spot may be offered to the next participant on the waiting list.

How do I pay if my child is registered? The payment link will be available after September 12th, once the club sponsor notifies you of your child's acceptance. Only admitted students will have access to pay.

- Click "View Details" for the club you want to register for.
- Add to cart, then checkout. You'll be redirected to Stripe to complete payment.

What if a club is canceled or suspended? If a club is canceled and will no longer take place, the registration fee will be credited back to your account.

When do clubs meet? Please see the attached club calendar. Clubs do not meet on testing days or holidays. Sponsors will notify parents via email if a meeting is canceled.

What if my child isn't picked up on time? Students may not wait in the aftercare program unless enrolled. If a student is not picked up on time, they will be signed into aftercare and charged the drop-in fee each time.



Extracurricular Catalogue – Tips & Disclaimers

1. **Registration Opens:** Wednesday, August 27th.
2. **Grade Level Eligibility:** Activities are only available to students in the listed grade levels. If an activity does not appear when registering, it is not available to your student.
3. **Meeting Schedule & Club Notifications:** Clubs will not meet on testing days or holidays. Sponsors will notify parents and participants in advance if a meeting is canceled.

Please note: Clubs are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Club sponsors will notify parents directly via email. If a student withdraws or has frequent absences, their spot may be offered to another participant on the next in line on the waiting list.
4. **Club Pick-Up & Aftercare Policy:** Students may not wait in the aftercare program unless they are officially enrolled. If a student is not picked up on time, they will be signed into aftercare and charged the drop-in fee each time this occurs.
5. **Commitment:** Registration signifies a commitment from both the student and parent. Students are expected to attend meetings regularly until the end of the activity/semester. Missing meetings does not cancel or withdraw membership.
6. **Refund Policy:** Payments are non-refundable except when an activity is canceled due to insufficient enrollment by the deadline. Refunds will not be issued for absences, scheduling conflicts, participation in other activities, withdrawal from Doral Academy, or disciplinary/academic issues resulting in removal from the program.
7. **Cancellations:** If a club is canceled and will no longer take place, the registration fee will be credited back to your original form of payment.
