#### Extracurricular Catalogue – Tips & Disclaimers

- 1. Registration will open on Wednesday, September 11th.
- Pay attention to the applicable grade levels in the catalogue. You will only be able to see activities that are available to your students. If an activity does not show it is not available to your student.
- 3. Meetings: No extracurricular activities will meet on Wednesdays, during testing or on holidays. Notifications will be sent to you on those days.
- 4. Students are not permitted to wait in the aftercare program unless they are already enrolled in it. If a student is not picked up on time, they will be signed into aftercare and be charged a drop-in fee.
- 5. Commitment: Registration is a commitment on behalf of the students and parents. By registering, the student is committing their time and willingness to participate until the end of the activity. Not attending meetings will not cancel or withdraw the student from membership.
- 6. Refunds: The extracurricular payment is non-refundable for any reason other than the activity not proceeding due to lack of registrations by the deadline. This includes but is not limited to absences, participation in other activities, scheduling conflicts, withdrawal from Doral Academy or discipline or academic problems that results in expulsion from the program.
- 7. If an activity does not proceed, the registration fee will be credited back to you.
